DECLARATION OF PHILIP RAY WORKMAN

Declarant Philip Ray Workman states as follows:

1. I am an adult resident citizen of Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee.
2. I have a sincerely held religious belief that "the body is the temple of the Holy Spirit."

I Corinthians 6:19. As stated in I Corinthians 3:16-17, "Do you now know that you are God's temple and that God's spirit dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple."

3. Based on the above passages, I have a sincere religious belief that my body is the temple of God. I believe that any invasion of my body for purposes not related to my medical treatment constitutes a desecration of God's temple.

4. I believe that any physical examination of my body beyond a visual inspection after my death would not be for the sake of my medical treatment. Therefore, any post-mortem physical violation of my body by means of piercing, puncturing, sampling, scraping, plucking, or withdrawal of fluid, no matter how slight any such procedure may be, would be a violation of my religious beliefs

5. In exercising my rights to personal autonomy, bodily integrity, personal human dignity, and to make decisions about my own body, I further declare that, other than my brother Terry Lee Workman and/or his authorized representative(s) or agents (and except as necessary to turn my body over to Terry Lee Workman or his designated representative(s) or agent(s)), should I be executed, I object to any other person(s) handling or touching my body, viewing it while disrobed, or in any way performing any procedure whatsoever upon my body or sampling, removing, or examining any tissue, fluid, or organ.
