To the Chief Justice of the Tennessee Supreme Court,

Based on the latest Tennessee Supreme Court Order, the 30<sup>th</sup> Judicial District wishes to modify the previously submitted Plan to Re-Open In-Court Proceedings for Shelby County Courts submitted on May 28, 2020 and approved by the Chief Justice. The following changes are being submitted for approval.

Social distancing will be maintained at 3 feet instead of 6 feet.

Virtual proceedings are still being encouraged whenever feasible.

In buildings under Shelby County control, the mask mandate will continue until June 11.

As to the other components of the plan that are not affected by the Supreme Court Order, they will remain in effect until normal court proceedings can be undertaken.
