**ORDER: (1) GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF TRIUMPH MOVIE'S
COUNSEL AND SETTING 4/4/16 NEW COUNSEL DEADLINE;
(2) SETTING 3/18/16 ANSWER DEADLINE FOR
DEFENDANTS NILSEN AND TNT; AND (3) SETTING 3/11/16
DEADLINE FOR PLAINTIFFS' NOTICE ON LEVY BANKRUPTCY**

It is ORDERED that the motion of Triumph Movie, LLC's Counsel to withdraw is granted.

It is further ORDERED that on or before April 4, 2016, any Notice of Appearance of Counsel for Triumph Movie, LLC shall be filed. Failure to meet this deadline may result in a default judgment being entered.


Further the 30-day deadline for Defendants Nilsen and TNT Consulting to formally respond to the complaint has passed. It is ORDERED that by March 18, 2016, a responsive pleading shall be filed by these Defendants. This deadline is issued to avoid delay and keep the

preliminary phase of joining and narrowing issues moving, preparatory to a Tennessee Civil Procedure Rule 16.02 Conference to enter a litigation plan for the case.

It is additionally ORDERED that on or before March 11, 2016, Plaintiffs' Counsel shall file a notice stating whether it has made a decision on seeking relief from the Automatic Bankruptcy Stay to pursue its claims against Defendant Levy in this case; or whether Plaintiffs shall litigate those claims in the Bankruptcy Court. If Plaintiffs have made this decision, it will assist this Court to be so informed in conducting the Rule 16.02 Case Litigation Plan Conference. If that decision can not be made at this time, Counsel shall so state.

After the above times for litigation events have passed, Counsel will be contacted for times and dates for the Rule 16.02 Conference.

The purpose of all the foregoing is, on the papers, to identify the parties participating in the litigation, join and narrow issues, and have claims and defenses identified for the Court in the pleadings. With these in place, the Court can conduct a Rule 16.02 Conference to establish an effective, cost-conscious case litigation plan.
