ORDER TO TRANSPORT ROBERT GLEN COE
TO MEMPHIS FOR COMPETENCY HEARING;
ORDER FOR STATE OF TENNESSEE TO RETAIN CUSTODY;
ORDER FOR SECURITY TO BE PROVIDED
BY THE STATE OF TENNESSEE FOR THE
DURATION OF ROBERT COE'S STAY IN MEMPHIS

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that Mr. Robert Glen Coe has a competency proceeding before this court scheduled for Monday, January 24, 2000, at 1:30 p.m.

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that Robert Coe, TDOC No. 92166 is currently housed at Riverbend Maximum Security Institution, Unit 2, A-212; 7475 Cockrill Bend Industrial Road, Nashville, Tennessee, 37209.

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that this case has incurred substantial media publicity. Furthermore, defense counsel has informed the court that Robert Coe has received threats against his life, and has in the past attempted suicide, all of the above warrant taking extraordinary security precautions for Mr. Coe during his proceedings in Memphis.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. Mr. Ricky Bell, Warden of Riverbend Maximum Security Institution, and the Tennessee Department of Corrections shall transport Robert Glen Coe, TDOC No. 92166, to Division III of the Criminal Court of Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee, on Monday, January 24, 2000. Mr. Coe shall be transported in time to have him present by 1:30 p.m. in Division III of the Criminal Court.

2. Mr. Coe shall remain in State custody and shall not be housed at the Shelby


County Jail during his stay in Memphis. If the hearing is not concluded on Monday, January 24, 2000, Mr. Coe shall be housed for the night at a State facility, such as Mark Luttrell Reception Center.

3. During the entire time Robert Coe is in Memphis, a guard shall be posted to observe Mr. Coe at all times except when he is conferring with counsel. Mr. Coe shall be housed in an isolation cell and shall never be allowed access to other inmates.

4. When the hearing has concluded, Mr. Coe shall promptly be returned to Riverbend Maximum Security Institute in Nashville, Tennessee.


5. The previous order requiring him to be transported on Sunday, January 23, 2000, is withdrawn.

IT IS SO ORDERED this 20th day of January, 2000.
