PRE-TRIAL ORDER

3. Any Motions in Limine must be filed on or before Noon (CST) on May 28, 2010. These matters will be heard by the entire Court before the trial begins on June 2, 2010.
4. Any stipulations agreed upon by the parties will be submitted in writing to the Presiding Judge of the Court of the Judiciary by Noon (CST) on June 1, 2010.
5. All exhibits intended to be introduced and an exhibit list will be exchanged by Noon (CST) on May 28, 2010.
6. If either party intends on using a VCR tape, DVD, Powerpoint presentation or any other form of evidence requiring the use of electronic equipment, that side will be required to provide its own technology.


