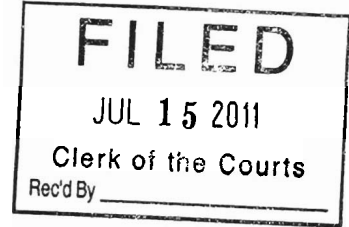



WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL OF RECOVERABLE COSTS

On June 30, 2011, Disciplinary Counsel for the Court of the Judiciary filed a Statement of Recoverable Costs with the Clerk of this Court in accordance with Rule 40 of the Tennessee Rules of Appellate Procedure. The Clerk of this Court prematurely approved those costs on July 14, 2011 as a response was not required to be filed by Judge Bell until July 15, 2011. Judge Bell did timely file an objection to the statement of recoverable costs on July 15, 2011.

Therefore, the Clerk's approval of the Statement of Recoverable Costs is withdrawn effective immediately. The Clerk of this Court will consider the Statement of Recoverable Costs and the Objections thereto and will issue a Clerk's Report in due course.
