This matter is before the Court on the Parties' request for entry of a new scheduling order, as evidenced by the signatures of counsel below. Because other matters pending between the State of Tennessee and Metro Nashville are time-sensitive and will likely generate additional deadlines throughout the autumn months, the Parties request that this matter be set for briefing and hearing in early 2024. Moreover, because the injunction issued in this case has maintained the status quo, the schedule proposed herein will permit the Court to resolve the remaining issues in sufficient time for Metro Nashville to draw new districts if Plaintiffs' claims are not successful.

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that:

(1) Motions for summary judgment shall be filed on or before Friday, January 26, 2024.

(2) Responses to motions for summary judgment shall be filed on or before Monday, February 26, 2024.

(3) Replies in support of motions for summary judgment shall be filed on or before Friday, March 8, 2024.

(4) A hearing on all motions for summary judgment shall be conducted [virtually / ~~in person~~] on Tuesday, March 26 , 2024, at .¹ 9:00 a.m. central / 10:00 a.m. eastern^{PHM}
