OPINION

The appellant, Allan Fyfe, Jr., was convicted by a jury of driving under the influence and reckless driving. He raises two issues on appeal: (1) whether the evidence was sufficient to convict; and (2) whether the trial court erred in failing to admit a witness' testimony.

Upon review of the record, we find no error of law mandating reversal; and the evidence is sufficient for the trier of fact to find the appellant guilty beyond a reasonable doubt. The trial court's judgment is, therefore, affirmed in accordance with Tenn. R. Ct. Crim. App., Rule 20.
