Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 11, section III(d) is hereby amended as follows:

d. Cases under advisement.

No case may be held under advisement in excess of sixty days and no motion, or other decision of the trial judge that delays the date of trial or final disposition in the trial court, shall be held under advisement for more than thirty days, absent the most compelling of reasons. (See Tenn. Code Ann. § 20-9-506) A MOTION TO RENDER DECISION **setting out the facts said to constitute a failure to comply with this rule** may be filed with the presiding judge and the circuit justice, or either of them.-by any attorney of record in a case, setting out the facts said to constitute a failure to comply with this rule.
