<sup>1</sup>The Court is particularly interested in the following issue: Whether the Court of Appeals erred in (reversing the trial court, which had granted summary judgment to the insurance company, and) ruling that summary judgment was not appropriate on the question whether the named insured party had, by making semiannual renewals of the automobile insurance policy, ratified his mother-in-law's election in the application for the policy on his behalf to obtain uninsured motorist coverage in amounts less than the policy's bodily injury liability coverage. This statement of the issue(s) for oral argument does not prevent the parties from raising additional issues pursuant to Rule 13(a), TRAP. It is also ordered that the parties shall file supplemental briefs addressing these issues. The appellant shall file the supplemental brief on or before 45 days from the date of this order, and the supplemental reply brief shall be filed within 30 days thereafter. The clerk is directed to submit this matter to the Court upon the completion of briefing as no oral argument will be required.
