  3. Do the other factors for mandatory review under Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-13-206(c)(1) require reversal of the sentence?
  4. Did the trial court abuse its discretion in admitting photographs of the victims' bodies?
  5. Did the trial court commit reversible error in limiting the defendant's mitigating evidence?
  6. Did the admission of victim impact evidence violate constitutional provisions against ex post facto laws?
