Such arrangements reinforce the fundamental importance of the parent-child relationship to the welfare of the child. The Tennessee Legislature established the Divorcing Parent Education and Mediation Fund (T.C.A. § 6-6-413) to help parents receive the necessary education and alternative dispute resolution services.
