
TEMPORARY AMENDMENT TO  
WRITTEN PLAN OF CIRCUIT, CHANCERY AND CRIMINAL COURTS FOR JURY TRIALS

Given the extraordinary rise of Covid-19 cases in Hamilton County, Tennessee, the area hospital population increases, and the steady decrease in juror availability; it is advisable to place a temporary suspension on jury trials for the safety of our Hamilton County jurors. Accordingly, and subject to the prior orders of the Tennessee Supreme Court and in the interest of the public health, all jury trials currently scheduled in the Eleventh Judicial District of the State of Tennessee for the remainder of November and continuing through January 1, 2021 are herein canceled.

It is therefore

**ORDERED** that all jury trials in the Eleventh Judicial District of the State of Tennessee effective immediately and continuing through January 1, 2021 are hereby canceled.
