ORDER AMENDING LOCAL RULE 3.1

This cause came before the Shelby County Criminal Court on the need to amend Rule 3.01 to allow electronic filing pursuant to Tenn. R. Crim. P. 49.2. To that end, the below amendment was drafted and published, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 18, to the Office of the Shelby County Public Defender, the Shelby County chapter of TACDL, the Office of the Shelby County District Attorney and the Criminal Law Section of the Memphis Bar Association for comment. Having solicited and received no unfavorable comments or suggestions for any alteration, this Court, sitting *en banc*, has decided that Local Rule 3.01 should be amended to read as follows, effective October 1, 2021:

All pleadings, including written motions, orders, briefs, and other papers submitted to the Court shall conform to Supreme Court Rule 36. The front page shall be captioned: "IN THE CRIMINAL COURT OF TENNESSEE FOR THE 30TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT AT MEMPHIS" and shall show the case number, the style, the crime charged, the nature of the paper filed, and the attorney's name, address, and registration number of the Tennessee Board of Professional Responsibility.

In accordance with Tenn.R.Crim.P. 49.2, electronic filing ("e-filing") is adopted for the Criminal Courts of Shelby County Tennessee for the Thirtieth Judicial District. In accordance with Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 46A, electronic service of e-filed papers shall apply for the Criminal Courts of Shelby County, Tennessee. The Electronic Filing Rules set forth and published by the Criminal Court Clerk's Office will govern the


effective date and rules for the electronic filing of cases, pleadings and other papers.

All papers, including pleadings, motions, briefs, and proposed judgments and orders, will be filed with or submitted to the clerk pursuant to this rule.

In Camera filings may not be e-filed and are required to be conventionally filed in paper format.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Criminal Court Judges hereby adopt the above amendment to Rule 3.1 of the Shelby County Criminal Court Rules of Practice and Procedure, effective October 1, 2021.






