

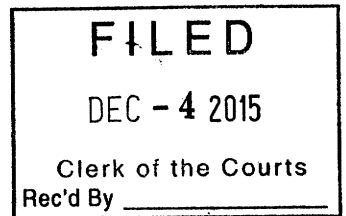

**ORDER**

Rule 42, Section 7(c), of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court currently states:

(c) Translation of Audio or Video Media. Services associated with the review or transcription/translation of audio or video tapes that include languages other than English shall be compensated at the same rate provided for spoken foreign language interpreters in *section 3 of this rule*.

(Emphasis added.) The reference to “section 3 of this rule” is incorrect, because section 7(a) is the section which sets the compensation rate for spoken foreign language interpreters. Accordingly, section 7(c) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(c) Translation of Audio or Video Media. Services associated with the review or transcription/translation of audio or video tapes that include languages other than English shall be compensated at the same rate provided for spoken foreign language interpreters in section 7(a) of this rule.

This amendment shall take effect upon the filing of this order.
