ORDER

It is hereby ORDERED that Rule 7, Rules of the Court of Criminal Appeals of Tennessee, is hereby amended by deleting the language of the Rule in its entirety and substituting the following:

Rule 7. Motions and Orders. Motions in this Court shall be in conformity with Rule 22, T.R.A.P. In addition, the proponent of a motion for an extension of time pursuant to Rule 21(b), T.R.A.P., shall submit a proposed order for the court's consideration. The proposed order shall comply with the standard format for appellate court orders prescribed by Rule 35, Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Tennessee. The proponent of a motion other than a motion for an extension of time is not required to submit a proposed order.
